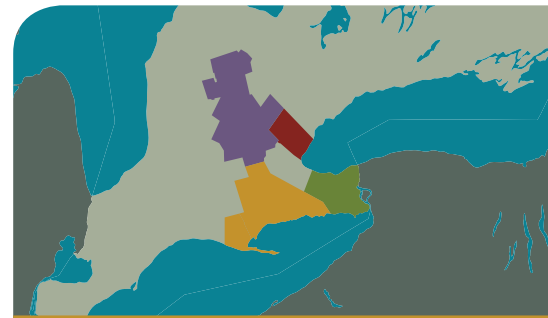

## Mac ■ CARE Benefits

For all participants: clerks, residents and preceptors. Mac-CARE provides support for UG and PG core and elective rotations which includes:

### McMaster Clerks and Residents

- Opportunity to live and learn in the same community
- In Mac-CARE region travel reimbursement funding, up to \$450 per 4 weeks, if the rotation meets eligibility criteria (in Mac-CARE region > 4 weeks ≥ 35km from academic home base)
- Mac-CARE preapproved and funded accommodations

### Preceptors

- Teaching stipend (\$1000 per 4 weeks)
