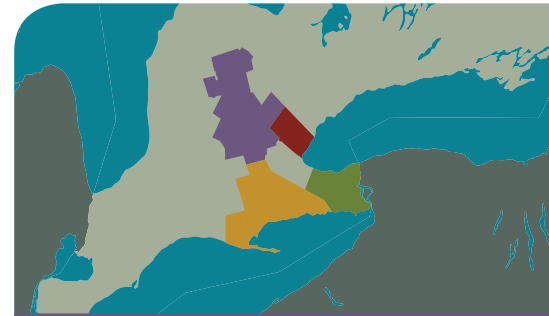
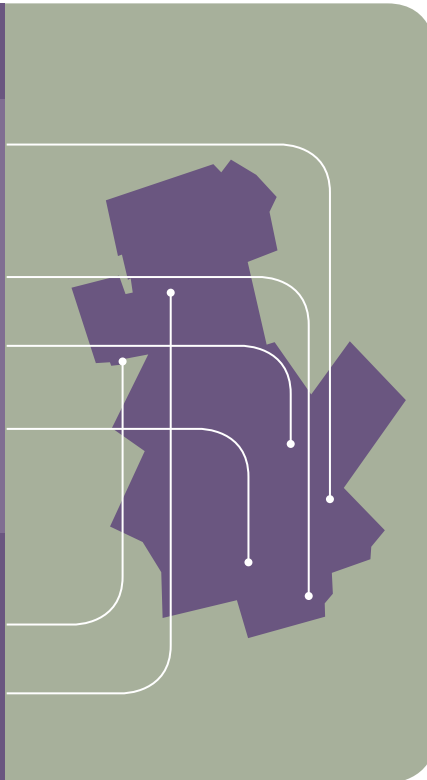

Waterloo Regional Campus (WRC) is a medical education campus (MEC) which provides a comprehensive medical education program for Undergraduate and Postgraduate learners.

- Waterloo Regional Campus opened in 2007 with 15 Undergraduate learners and 7 Family Medicine Postgraduate residents. WRC region is comprised of the Waterloo, Wellington and Grey counties
- In 2011, WRC saw the expansion of 3 Royal College residency positions in Medicine and Psychiatry
- Currently, WRC has a yearly enrolment of 28 UG students, 17 PGFM residents and 4 Royal College Residents
- Our current UG and PG core and elective activity is over 400 rotations per year
